Temporary Aquatics Aide

\$18.10 - \$21.95 Hourly

Minimum Qualifications: High school diploma or GED (desirable); No prior experience is required. CPR/First Aid/AED Certification (must attain within three months of hire). **NOTE:** The City of West Hollywood, Recreation Services Division will provide the certification courses to qualified, passing candidates. Employment is contingent based upon successful completion of the required certifications. Availability to work a flexible schedule including weekends, holidays and/or on-call status is essential.

Temporary Lifeguard

\$22.25 - \$28.43 Hourly

Minimum Qualifications: No prior experience is required. Familiarity with Aquatics programs and aquatics facilities, teamwork skills, customer service experience, proficient computer skills, and lifeguarding background/experience is desirable; StarGuard Elite Lifeguard Certification; Starfish Aquatics Swim Instructor Certification (certification provided through the City's Aquatics Academy). Must be 16 years of age or older by JUNE 1, 2023. Availability to work a flexible schedule including opening and closing shifts, weekends and holidays. **Water Skills Assessment and Swim Proficiency:** Must pass initial water skills assessment and swim proficiency test during the recruitment process.

Applications will be accepted on a continuous basis. Applicants are encouraged to apply early to receive priority consideration.

Selection process: As part of the selection process, qualified candidates will be invited to an interview with the Recreation leadership team. Qualified candidates for the Lifeguard position will also be invited to a Water Skills Assessment and Swim Proficiency test. The first round of interviews and swim tests will be held on **Tuesday, April 4, 2023.**
